Chargers

I'm often asked if the car or motorbike charger will charge the battery for the pigeon magnet.

The simple answer is yes; but not for long, as you will rapidly wreck your battery, shortening its life and potentially compromising a good days shooting or lamping session.

You should not charge SLA batteries at a rate above 25% of the Ah capacity.

You should not fully discharge SLA batteries, contrary to the popular myth.

You should recharge SLA batteries as soon as possible after use, and if possible keep them on a low trickle charge until required.

Shooters fail batteries more often than batteries fail shooters!

The chargers listed below are those that I recommend to cover the range of batteries highlighted
